 Washunga Days is an annual festival which celebrates the culture both past and present- of Council Grove, showcasing the city and all of its amenities. The weekend celebration offers activities and entertainment for everyone of all ages.

The proceeds of the festival provide the Council Grove/Morris County Chamber of Commerce & Tourism funding to promote the area, ultimately supporting the community at large. A portion of the funds are retained each year for "seed" money to support the following year's festival.
