Purpose: Distribution shall be made exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary or education purposes or for the prevention of cruelty to children or animals with in Morris County, Kansas.

Section 501(c)(3). Such payments and distribution shall be made exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes or for the prevention of cruelty to children or animals and shall be in such amounts and upon such terms and at such times as the Trustees, in their sole and absolute discretion, may direct.

SECOND: The payments and distributions to be made by the Trustees under Article FIRST, above, shall be made to or for the use of the following described beneficiaries as the Trustees, in their sole and absolute discretion, shall determine:

- A.) The State of Kansas, or any political subdivisions thereof; the County of Morris, or any political subdivisions thereof, specifically including, but not limited to, the Morris County Hospital; the City of Council Grove and other incorporated municipalities within Morris County, Kansas; to be used by any or all of them exclusively for public purposes in the areas and endeavors stated above;
- B.) Senior Citizens Centers, groups or organizations which may be organized, not for profit, offering facilities, services and fellowship for the benefit and enjoyment of senior citizens and located in Morris County, Kansas;
- C.) Public school districts organized under the laws of the State of Kansas and having one or more attendance centers in Morris County, Kansas, specifically including Unified School District No. 417 and Unified School District No. 481 and their successors;
- D.) Any tax supported college, university, trade or vo-tech school, located within the State of Kansas and which are attended by students who are residents of or native to Morris County, Kansas;
- E.) The Diamond Springs and Wilsey Cemeteries, to be used for the care, maintenance and improvements of said cemeteries;
- F.) The Christian and Methodist Churches located in Wilsey and Council Grove, Kansas, to be used as the governing bodies of those churches may direct;
- G.) A corporation, trust, community chest, fund, foundation, council or board,
  - 1.) created or organized under the laws of the State of Kansas;

- 2.) organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes which are within Morris County, Kansas;
- 3.) no part of the net earnings of which inures to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual connected therewith;
- 4.) no substantial part of the activities of which is the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation.

THIRD: By way of clarification of the distributions or payments to be made to the above beneficiaries, the Grantors wish to state that it is not their intention or desire to relieve or release any of the governing bodies of the beneficiaries set forth in Paragraph A of Article SECOND, above, from their duty and obligation to supply and furnish to the taxpayers those goods, services and facilities normally supplied and furnished to the taxpayers of similarly situated entities, it being the purpose of this foundation to enable the beneficiaries named therein to supply and furnish goods, services and facilities to the taxpayers which they would not otherwise be required or necessarily expected to supply or furnish. The Grantors further state that any distributions or payments to the beneficiaries set forth in Paragraph D of Article SECOND, above, shall be based upon the costs of tuition and books at said institutions and the number of students attending a particular institution who are residents or native to Morris County, Kansas.

FOURTH: It being the intention of the parties that the foundation hereby created be perpetual in existence, the Trustees shall not distribute any part of the principal or corpus of the trust, but shall be limited to a distribution and payment of the interest, income or earnings from principal or corpus. Any other provisions of this instrument notwithstanding, the Trustees shall distribute its income for each taxable year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.
