What is the purpose of this project; what specifically will it accomplish?

The Spot Vision Screener allows for vision screening of all children (and staff if needed). For those students that are unable to verbally answer or follow the direction of the screener, this device allows for ease of obtaining accurate screening results just by taking a simple picture. It is especially important when trying to screen younger children, and it can catch some possible diagnosis that a regular eye chart test cannot catch. It is very important to catch vision difficulties early in school to help students excel in the classroom and not fall behind.
